Whooping Cough (Pertussis) Vaccination for Pregnant Women

The Department of Health have rolled out a vaccination programme for women who are between the stages of 28-38 weeks in their pregnancy.

111 - New Out of Hours Number

NHS 111 is a new national telephone service being introduced to make it easier for people to access local health services when they have an urgent need. It replaces NHS Direct and provides a general number for people to call when they have an urgent need, but not, a life threatening 999 emergency. From 18th February 2013 this number will replace our current out of hours number (Grab A Doc). 28th February 2013 NHS 111 goes live for all calls including Out of Hours and NHS Direct. Information Leaflets and posters are available at both practices.
